1. Some data submitted with this annual report may not align with previous year reports. This is due to Moreno Valley College moving to use the California Community College Student Success Metrics as our baseline for responding to this report. The college's response to 16b Transfer is one example. Currently the California Community College Student Success Metrics only provide transfer data through 2016-2017. Transfer outcomes for 2017-2018 will be available for the 2020 ACCJC Annual Report. Lastly, the college is aligning internal strategic objectives with the Student Success Metrics.

2. Institution set standards were modified and stretch goals were set as part of our annual review process. Along with the shift to using the Student Success Metrics, this has caused a shift in some institution set standards compared to previous years.

3. In response to question 18 - Employment rates for Career and Technical Education students, years in which there was unreliable data is indicated by "n/a". In addition, the college is now measuring job placement rates for career and technical education students using Federal Perkins data. Previously, the college had used an internal survey instrument. This change has caused some differences with prior year reports.
