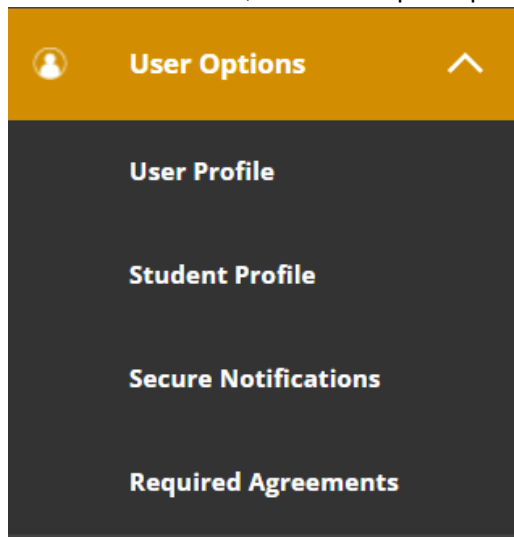


The Academics menu allows for quick navigation to academic related actions and information.

CCPGB CA College Promise Grant B, Formerly BOG - The California College Promise Grant (CCPG) is a state fee waiver program that is specifically for California resident or eligible non-resident students at California community colleges. CCPG waives the per-unit enrollment (currently \$46 per unit) at any community college throughout the state. CCPG is for California residents, eligible AB540 students and eligible AB1899 students. CCPG waivers are not a cash award; however, the waivers are available to all students who qualify, regardless of the amount of units enrolled and are applied to enrollment fees as a year-round entitlement. The CCPG is contingent upon meeting academic and progress standards throughout the year.

Please note: not all courses are approved for financial assistance. A list of courses that are not approved to receive grant or loan funds is available at the Student Financial Services counter.

Remember to pay any fees due before the fee deadline dates to avoid being dropped from classes. If you have paid your fees for previous semesters during this academic year, you may be eligible for a refund.

RCCD has assumed your housing location as "off campus" instead of "with parent".
