



Upward Bound/ Upward Bound Math & Science Application

The Federal TRIO Programs (TRIO) are outreach and student services programs designed to identify and provide services for individuals from first generation and/or income qualifying backgrounds to help them prepare for and graduate from college. The Upward Bound Program and the Upward Bound Math & Science Program are federally funded through the US Department of Education under Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 to help students overcome class, social, academic and cultural barriers to higher education.

Upward Bound Program (Valley View HS)

The Upward Bound (UB) Program was the first TRIO Program established in 1964. MVC's UB is part of the national TRIO programs in partnership Moreno Valley Unified School District (MVUSD). UB is an interactive intensive pre-college experience designed to prepare students from low-income, first-generation backgrounds for college. UB will serve a cohort of 60 high students from Valley View High School of which over two-thirds are from low income, first-generation backgrounds.

Upward Bound Math and Science Program (Vista del Lago HS)

The Moreno Valley College (MVC) Upward Bound Math and Science Program (UBMS) is part of the national TRIO programs in partnership with the Moreno Valley Unified School District (MVUSD). UBMS is an interactive intensive pre-college experience designed to strengthen the math and science skills of participating high school students. UBMS helps students recognize and develop their potential to excel in math while encouraging them to pursue postsecondary degrees, and ultimately careers in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). Each year, UBMS annually serves a cohort of 62 students from Vista del Lago High School of which over two-thirds are from first-generation backgrounds. MVC's UBMS program has been in existence since October 2012.
